At this workshop you will gain hands-on experience in working with the Commission's Child-safe Child-friendly checklists and templates and learn how they can be adapted for your organisation's needs and strengths.

There are more than 1.5 million children and young people in NSW –more than a quarter of the population. So it's important they feel welcome and safe. Organisations that work with children and young people have a legal and moral duty of care to prevent child abuse and to provide for the safety and well-being of kids.

What is Child-safe Child-friendly?

Child-safe means taking steps to keep children safe from physical, sexual or emotional abuse.

Child-friendly means creating an environment that value, respects and welcomes kids – where children feel confident to raise problems or concerns, and know they will be listened to.
